

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy describes how CH Law processes personal data in our case handling and potential KYC procedures.

Personal data includes any form of information about an identifiable individual such as the person's name, email address, CPR number, address, as well as any client's ultimate owners.

The relevant rules are: General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation No. 2026/679 of April 27, 2026) and the Danish Data Protection Act (Act No. 502 of May 23, 2018).

For the purpose of providing services to clients CH Law collects, processes (record, organize, adapt, alter, retrieve, use and disclose) and stores various types of personal data, including name, position, email, telephone, address. Data is collected directly from the client or from third parties, public authorities or databases.

CH Law will process such personal data in the performance of our legal advisory services to clients on general legal and corporate matters, including on connection with drafting and negotiation of contracts, due diligence, transactions, board work, demands for payments, ongoing advice, etc. The legal basis for the processing of the personal data is to comply with legal obligations and to pursue the legitimate interests of CH Law in the performance of legal advisory services.

We keep your information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose for which the personal data was collected. Afterwards, the information will be deleted. As a general rule, case files are kept for a maximum of (5) five years.

As data subjects you have the right to request access to personal information including its source, purposes of processing, and recipients, to the extent they are disclosed. If you reach out to CH Law, we will do our utmost to look into the matter and make necessary changes and/or deletions right away. You have a possibility to complaint about the handling of your personal data to Datatilsynet, Borgergade 38, 1300 København K.
